**The Product of Willie Lynch BY IFE ABDULAL MUHAMMAD**

Willie Lynch was a successful slave master from the West Indies in the 1700's. He was a hero of slave owners. He perfected the art of slave holding. He was considered to be the grand master of slave masters - The Billy Graham of Slavery. Lynch began holding conventions on how to create the perfect slave. As a result, he created the most traumatic and devastating form of genocide known to man: The destruction of the African man. This is an adaptation of one of his most famous speeches of 1712.

Gentlemen, first I shall thank you for bringing me here. I am here to help solve the problems with your slaves. I caught a whiff of a dead slave hanging a couple of miles back. You are not only losing valuable stock by hanging. You are having uprisings and slaves are running away. I have a fool proof method for controlling your black slaves.
